

Be it remembered, that on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Fifty three the following marriage license was issued by the Clerk of the Tipton Circuit Court, to-wit:

State of Indiana, Tipton County, Ind: The State of Indiana to any person empowered by law to solemnize marriages in said county, Greeting: You are hereby duly authorized to join together as husband and wife Richard Freeman & Rheumela Ayers

In testimony whereof, I, Alex M. Gentry clerk of the Tipton Circuit Court, have hereunto set my hand, and affixed the seal of said court, at Tipton this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1853.

And afterwards, to-wit: on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 53<sup>rd</sup>, Ureah Gorris returned to and filed in the office of the clerk of said court the following certificate, to-wit:

State of Indiana, Tipton county, Ind: I, Ureah Gorris a Justice of the Peace in said county, do certify that on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of September 1853, I joined together as husband and wife Richard Freeman and Rheumela Ayers
