

Be it remembered, that on the 9th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Fifty three the following marriage license was issued by the Clerk of the Tippecanoe Circuit Court, to-wit:

State of Indiana, Tippecanoe County, Ict: The State of Indiana to any person empowered by law to solemnize marriages in said county, Greeting: You are hereby duly authorized to join together as husband and wife Richard Freeman & Phenemela Ayers

In testimony whereof, I, Alex M. Young clerk of the Tippecanoe Circuit Court, have hereunto set my hand, and affixed the seal of said court, at Tippecanoe this 9th day of September A.D. 1853.

And afterwards, to-wit: on the 14th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and 53rd, Uresh Gorres returned to and filed in the office of the clerk of said court the following certificate, to-wit:

State of Indiana, Tippecanoe county, Ict: I, Uresh Gorres a Jurist of the Peace in said county, do certify that on the 11th day of September 1853, I joined together as husband and wife Richard Freeman and Phenemela Ayers
