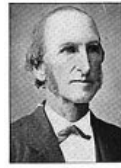


Family Group Sheet for Solomon Von Nieda & Elizabeth Fry

 Comment: United Brethren Reverend; ordained, East Pennsylvania Conference
 Occupation: Bef. 1853 in Congregations at Myerstown, Reading and Hummelstown; Miller; Preacher in the United Brethren Church; transferred to Ohio in 1853; was Publishing agent of the "Religious Telescope" & other U.B. publications from 1853/1854, Jun 1855 to 1861 & 1861-1864; editor from 1859 to 1866, Bookkeeper from 1869 to 1880
 d: 22 Jul 1880 in Dayton, Montgomery Co., OH; age at death; 71yrs 3mths 28ds
 Burial: 24 Jul 1880 in Woodland Cemetery, Dayton, OH (Sec 101 Lot 1420)
 Probate: 31 Dec 1881 in Montgomery Co., OH
 Religion: United Brethren. He received a license to preach Dec, 1844 and joined the Penn Conference Feb, 17, 1845, Bishop J. Erb presiding. He was ordained an elder in the Church on Feb, 28, 1848 by Bishop J. Russell. From 1845 to 1853 Solomon devoted his whole time and powers to the ministry

1840 Penn Census, Lancaster Co., East Donegal Township

1850 Penn Census (Sept 27, 1850) Lebanon Co., Myerstown: Solomon age 41, Elizabeth age 36, Martha age 12, Elizabeth age 7, Anna age 6.

1860 Ohio Census(June 26) Dayton City, 5th Ward: Solomon age 50, Eliza age 45, Martha age 21, Eliza age 18, Anna age 16, Solomon age 7, John age 4, Mary age 2.

1870 Ohio Census, Dayton, 6th Ward: Solomon, Elizabeth & son Solomon age 17. The younger children, John & Mary are not listed in the household; possibly deceased.

1880 Ohio Census, Dayton, Dis 155: Elizabeth age 65, Sol age 71, Martha Jackson gdau. age 11.

ZION CHURCH OF THE UNITED BROTHERS IN CHRIST was organized in 1847 by Rev. S. Noll. Rev. S. Vonieda took charge in 1848.

Montgomery County, Dayton, OH

The Second United Brethren Church (German) was organized in 1853. In 1855 a one-story brick church edifice was erected on Wayne Street, near Jones. Solomon Vonneida was one of the church's pastors.

1920 Ohio Census; Montgomery Co., Washington Twp., Dis 240: Soloman, Eva, son Harry, dau-in-law Ella & gr-son Russell.
