Mrs. Martha J. Freeman, 85, died early Saturday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. J. W. Lively, about six miles west of Bowie

Funeral services were held at 3 o'clock Saturday afternoon at Mrs. Lively's home conducted by Rev. P. S. Warren. Methodist minister at Sunset. Burial was in Brushy cemetery directed by Burgess Funeral directors.

Mrs. Freeman was a native Texan and was reared in Montague county.

Besides her daughter, she is survived by several grandchildren and a sister, Mrs. I. M. Grimes of Sunset.

In this obituary, "Martha Freeman is survived by her daughter Mrs J.W. Lively and a sister, Mrs I.M. Grimes.

Further research of records on familysearch.org and findagrave.com shows, or suggests, that Mrs Grimes is Mary Adilee "Mollie" Johnson married to Francis "Frank" Marion Grimes. There is a Grimes family with a 10 year old F.M. Grimes, living next to Mary Warwick Vance in the 1850 Montague, TX census.

Martha J. Johnson married William Freeman in Montague County, Texas, 13 Feb 1873. Citing this record:

They had a daughter, Nettie born 1 Dec 1879. I find Nettie and her husband, Thomas W Pollard (married 4 Jul 1894), along with their daughter, Effie, living with Martha J Freeman in the 1900 census (Forestburg, Montague County, TX) a few homes away from Richard C. Freeman and his family.

In the 1910 census, Wise County, Nettie Pollard is widowed and living with her mother, Martha Freeman, and 2 children, Effie and Weldon (Thomas Weldon Pollard)
